HEADQUARTERS DEPARTMENT OF THE ARMY WASHINGTON, DC, 6 July 1970

- I_GENERAL COURTS-MARTIAL. The Commanding General, 1st Infantry Division (MECH) and Fort Riley, Fort Riley, Kansas, is designated by the Secretary of the Army, pursuant to the Uniform Code of Military Justice, Article 22(a) (6), to convene general courts-martial effective 30 June 1970.
- II._ARMY PICTORIAL CENTER, NEW YORK. Effective 30 June 1970, the Army Pictorial Center, New York, a class II installation under the jurisdiction of the Commanding General, U.S. Army Materiel Command, is placed in an inactive status.
- III_BOSTON ARMY BASE, MASSACHUSETTS. Effective 30 June 1970, Boston Army Base, Massachusetts, a class I installation under the jurisdiction of the Commanding General, First U.S. Army, is discontinued as a Department of the Army installation.
- IV_SENIOR ROTC UNITS. 1. So much of DA General Orders 81, 17 December 1968, as pertains to the establishment of a Senior ROTC unit at Boise State College, Boise, Idaho, is rescinded.
- 2. Effective 30 June 1970, the Senior ROTC unit at Boston University, Boston, Massachusetts, will be disestablished.
- 3. Effective 31 August 1970, the Senior ROTC unit at Allen Military Academy, Bryan, Texas, will be disestablished. General Order 25, 15 June 1966, establishing a class MI Junior ROTC, unit remains in effect.
