I----UNITED STATES ARMY ENGINEER SCHOOL. Effective 1 June 1988, the United States Army Engineer School is relocated from Fort Belvoir, Virginia to Fort Leonard Wood, Missouri.

II---UNITED STATES ARMY ENGINEER CENTER AND FORT BELVOIR. Effective 1 October 1988, the United States Army Engineer Center and Fort Belvior (UIC: TCWOUYAA), an installation under the command of the Commanding General, U. S. Army Training and Doctrine Command, Fort Monroe, Virginia, is transferred to the command of the Commanding General, U. S. Army Military District of Washington, Fort Lesley J. McNair, Washington D. C. and is redesignated U. S. Army Fort Belvoir (UIC: MWW4VNAA).

III--UNITED STATES ARMY TRAINING CENTER ENGINEER AND FORT LEONARD WOOD. Effective 2 October 1988, the United States Army Training Center Engineer and Fort Leonard Wood (UIC: TCWOVLAA) is redesignated the United States Army Engineer Center and Fort Leonard Wood (UIC: TCWOVLAA).
